



Social Service Initiatives Guidelines

The Upper Saddle River community is one that is exceptionally generous in spirit and acutely aware of their surroundings. In addition to our own social service clubs (Cavallini Cares, Leo Club, YGC Juniors), we have many students heavily involved in Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, religious organizations and completing their eighth grade service learning project. We also frequently hear from alumni interested in executing their own initiatives.

In an effort to manage this amazing “problem”, and to demonstrate fairness, we have installed the following guidelines that apply to all social service initiatives that are not directly connected to our school clubs.

All requestors will be afforded the following opportunities:

- Two Collection Boxes (*1 outside the Auditorium / 1 in the Glass Hallway*) for 10 consecutive school days.
- Two Informational Flyers (*1 outside the Main Office / 1 Outside the Health Office*) for 10 consecutive school days.
- Informational Announcement (*not a feature*) to run for 5 consecutive school days.

****Please inquire at the Main Office about gaining approval and securing your dates for the above opportunities. We will attempt to grant each initiative exclusivity and refrain from having more than two initiatives executing simultaneously.***

Lastly, we are typically moved and impressed by the various initiatives that our students and alumni embrace. It is our intention to support all of them, equally, at a level that doesn't cause saturation. In that vein, in order to be equitable to all, requests surpassing the above opportunities will not be granted. It is our hope that these efforts toward supporting equally are not misinterpreted as unappreciative or obstructive.
