Mrs. D'Ambola and Dr. Siegel presented the standardized testing results for the 2016-17 school year. These results included 2017 PARCC scores for grades 3 - 8 in both ELA and Language Arts. Overall, the district is experiencing an increase in the percentage of students meeting and exceeding grade level

standards for both content areas. The district reported an increase in the overall participation rate and will focus on increasing performance within the subgroup of special education. NJ ASK Science, Access 2.0, and DLM assessment results were also shared with the public. Detailed reports are guiding professional development with teachers as well as individual conferences with parents seeking to learn more about their child's strengths and weaknesses.

2. HIB Presentation, School Self-Assessment and 2016/17 Report Period 2

Mr. DeSocio

Mr. DeSocio presented the Annual School Self-Assessment Report for the 2016/17 school year which is required by the New Jersey Department of Education in accordance with the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act. Highlights of his presentation included:

Out of a possible 78 points, Reynolds scored 71 points, Bogert scored 71 points and Cavallini scored 70 points. The District Grade was 71.
